Year 4 – The Vikings 793 – 1066

Crucial Knowledge

- The Vikings came from Scandinavia (Norway, Denmark and Sweden).
- They travelled across water in longships (a long boat).
- They invaded (forced their way in to) Britain and were violent.
- The Vikings wanted to travel because the climate (temperature) in Scandinavia was too poor for farming, fishing and hunting.
- The Viking men were: fighters, hunters, farmers, tradesmen
- Women worked on farms, took care of children and also learnt how to fight.
- Many Vikings were slaves in Scandinavia but once they arrived in Britain, they were able to escape and make a home.

Intent

- Recap Local history: pottery, bricks and Romans (Years 2, 3 and 4)
- Show the Viking time period on the history timeline in relation to previous history learning
- An introduction to the Vikings: who they were and where they came from
- Invasion: when and why the Vikings invaded Britain
