Crucial Knowledge

- A globe is a model of planet Earth.
- Planet Earth is the planet we live on.
- A continent is a group of countries. There are seven continents on Earth.
- An ocean is a very large amount of water (bigger than the sea). There are five oceans on Earth.
- The North Pole is at the top of planet Earth.
- The South Pole is at the bottom of planet Earth.
- The equator is an invisible line around the middle of the Earth.
- Countries close to the equator are always warm (hot).
