<ul style="list-style-type: none">• World War II started in 1939 and ended in 1945 (8th May for Europe).• The War started because the Germans invaded Poland (under the leadership of Adolf Hitler).• England and France declared war on Germany (3rd September 1939).• There were two sides to the war – The Allies and the Axis.• The Allies were countries who supported Britain.• The Axis were countries who supported Germany.• Many 'little ships' rescued thousands of soldiers stuck at Dunkirk in France.• The Battle of Britain was the German's attempt to invade Britain.• Many places were bombed in Britain during the Blitz.• The Allies won the war in 1945 when the Germans surrendered (gave up).• Alan Turing made a computer to crack the German code machine.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recap - The Roman Empire (Year 4) and establish position of World War II on the history timeline• How the war began.
