### Year 1 - Christianity

#### **Crucial Knowledge**

- There are two symbols (signs) for Christians: a cross and a fish.



- Harvest is when food is shared with other people.
- A Christingle is used to count down the weeks until Christmas.
- The Nativity Story is about when Jesus was born. We celebrate this at Christmas time.
- When Jesus was a man, he died on a cross.
- Before Jesus died, he went to a desert for 40 days to think. People 'give up' things to remember this.
- Christians go to church to worship (think about) Jesus and God (who was Jesus' father).

#### **Intent**

- **Exploring:**
  - Symbols (signs) and objects of the church
  - Harvest
- Christmas:
  - Making a Christingle
  - The Nativity Story.
- **Engaging:**
  - Stories that Jesus told:
    - The Good Samaritan (helping others)
    - The Lost sheep and the lost coin (being sorry and happy for others)
    - The House on the Rock (hard work)
- Easter
  - Giving up (Lent)
  - Easter: Jesus died on a cross
- **Reflecting:**
  - Christian worship: church, prayers, hymns.
  - Things that Jesus did
