### Year 4 – Living Things and their Habitats

<b>Crucial Knowledge</b>	<b>Intent</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Living things can be plants or animals that breathe <u>and</u> grow.</li><li>• A habitat is a home that gives food and shelter. <i>(Example, the habitat of a blackbird is a tree and the space around it).</i></li><li>• Habitats are different because animals and plants are different.</li><li>• Environments means anything that is around us.</li><li>• Environments can change.
